The Riverside City Council meeting opened at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall with Mayor Allen Schneider requesting roll call. Council members present: Tom Sexton, Ryan Rogerson, Lois Schneider, Kevin Mills, and Kevin Kiene.

Motion by Sexton, second by Mills to approve agenda. Passed 5-0.

Motion by Kiene, second by Rogerson to approve consent agenda of minutes, expenditures. Motion carried 5-0.

Kate Giannini of Washington County Soil and Water Conservation District and 4H Enterpriser Club reported on naming "Lincoln Gate" as the creek on the east side of Riverside. Mayor signed letter of support to the U.S. Board of Names to approve the creek name.

Rogerson moved, second by Sexton, to pass resolution 2024-87, appointing Farmer's and Merchants Savings Bank and IPAIT as City depositories for calendar year 2025. Passed 5-0.
