 - b. Junk and Unused Vehicles
 - i. Damaged, inoperable, or unused within last 30 days
 - ii. Must be removed within 5 days
 - 1. Certified mail or municipal infraction process

c. Trees

- i. Planting Restrictions
 - 1. Can be planted midway between outer line of sidewalk and curb. If no curbline, must be planted 10 feet from property line.
 - Cannot be planted in Right of Way that is less than 9 feet wide of 81 square feet
 of exposed surface soil per tree. Cannot be planted closer than 20 feet of an
 intersection and 10 feet from driveways. Planting location preference is given to
 inside the property line.
 - 3. No fruit bearing trees or cottonwood, poplar, box elder, Chinese elm, evergreen, willow, or black walnut can be planted along streets.
- ii. Trimming (5 day notice)
 - 1. 15 feet above streets
 - 2. 8 feet above sidewalks
- iii. Inspection & Removal
 - 1. City Council may cause any tree that is suspected to be infected or damaged to be inspected and removed.

d. Weeds, Vines, & Brush

- Notice by Publication Only (published by April 15th of each year) in effect from May 1st through October 31st
 - 1. Developed Areas- No taller than 8 inches or 3 inches in diameter
 - 2. Undeveloped Areas- No taller than 18 inches or 3 inches in diameter
- ii. Vegetable and flower gardens are exempt as long as they are purposefully planted
- iii. Pollinator gardens require a permit including:
 - 1. Maintenance Plan
 - 2. Site plan with compliant buffer strips
 - 3. Sign with permit number must be displayed
 - 4. Cannot be taller than 3 feet
